The pastor has reported new relationships being made, connections being forged, and staff excitement having improved.

Lobby Area/Pastor's Office Before Photos

The original lobby was cramped and tight with zero connecting space. A clear children's check-in area was also missing.



Lobby/Connecting Area After Photos

Walls and offices were removed to create an open area where people can gather. A sleek concrete flooring with epoxy finish was installed for durability, low maintenance, and aesthetics.



The pastor's office was removed to create a large, warm, and inviting atmosphere for connection and relationship building. It is also used frequently for meetings and gatherings.

A storage room was removed to create an expansive and highly visible children's check-in area. Seating was added for parents to relax and have conversation.

Behind the check-in wall, the size of the existing nursery was increased and it was tastefully updated for a fresh, modern look.

Offices were cramped and disjointed. There was limited space to work effectively as a team.

Offices were relocated to one central area. Having individual offices branched off a conjoined space allows for increased collaboration and communication.



A small kitchenette and storage area is adjacent to the collaborative office area. Staff members have supplies and snacks close at hand.
